# Technical Specification and Rider

- 3 x Vocal Mic - 3 x Shure Beta 87 or similar (Skelpt will provide mics). Mic stands must include a boom arm
- 2 x Bodhran Mic - Andrew and Euan provide their own drum mics  
Andrew - Sennheiser Drum Mic, Euan - AKG518 Drum Mic (48v required)
- 2 x Guitar - both electro acoustic, requires DI.
- 1 x Fiddle - requires DI.

At least one monitor with the main mix, ideal 3 monitors with individual mixes available.

Iain Stage left, Euan Centre Stage (please include a high stool), Andrew Stage Right (Iain and Andrew stand)



## Food and drink.

Euan is vegetarian and meal must adhere to this, Andrew does not like cucumber. Prior to performing it is best not to have too large a meal, and for any food to have only a little dairy and not to be too spicy. Having a some apples and bananas is always nice.

Drinks required, Water, tea, coffee. A beer or glass of wine is nice after performing

## Accommodation

Must include individual rooms. It is preferable to have tea and coffee making facilities and a fridge
